DECISION OF THE CHRISTCHURCH DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE



Take notice that pursuant to s231(4) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Christchurch District Licensing Committee does not approve the appointment of Maia-Grace Herma Billie Tipene as a Temporary Manager of premises known as Supreme Supreme in respect of which an On Licence is in force.

The proposed appointment is opposed by the NZ Police. The Committee's attention has been drawn to a series of breaches of the Land Transport Act which suggest that Ms Tipene has a disregard for compliance with the law. This does not give the Committee confidence that she would uphold the provisions of the Sale & Supply of Alcohol Act. We do not consider it appropriate that she should be a Temporary Manager at this time.

s231(5) of the Act requires the appointment to be terminated no later than five working days after the date of this notice.
