SUBMISSION: PROPOSED CHANGES TO DENTON PARK

I do **not** support the proposed management plan and part reserve classification changes to Denton Park for the following reasons:

Denton Park

1. Traffic congestion

The traffic flow around Hornby Mall is already congested and is an 'accident waiting to happen'. For residents who use this mall regularly – many of whom are elderly or have limited mobility – access to carparks and the mall has become more and more difficult, especially since the 2010-2011 earthquakes and the mall extension.

The goods vehicles off-loading their wares for Pak'n'Save and the bus stop which has been placed near to a very dangerous corner add to the problem. It appears that there has been no thought given to pedestrian access and/or safety, and the carpark is already full-to-overflowing every day of the year.

With the proposed changes to the District Plan, this situation would only be made worse by having more vehicular traffic coming into or going out of Chalmers Street and Main South Road. The people who would use the proposed swimming pool, library and service centre would put more pressure on existing parking facilities.

Older children and teenagers who would perhaps use the swimming pool would no doubt bring their bicycles, and where is it proposed that these be safely housed?

I feel that this is a poor indictment on Council planning skills. I suggest a site visit is arranged as well as listening to the local people who live, shop and work in the area.

2. Sports facilities

The loss of a playing field for Hornby Rugby Club and Hornby Cricket Club's senior ground would be a severe blow to our community. These two well-run sports clubs are long-established facilities and have served our sports people well for many years. They are central which allows for younger members of the clubs to take up the sport of

their choice and either walk or bus to the venue. Our youngsters need these activities as it is well-known that playing sport teaches them many skills like team playing and leadership – things our society desperately need.

3. Vandalism and graffiti

Increased vandalism along with graffiti could be expected as certain individuals seem to hang out around gaming outlets and swimming pools. This not only occurs on buildings but damage to parked cars is becoming more prevalent as well.

4. Litter

There would be increased litter as well. People tend to feel hungry after swimming so would frequent the take-away venues and then leave their rubbish anywhere except in the proper receptacle.

5. Noise

People coming to shop do not want to be confronted by youths yelling and screaming, and generally making a nuisance of themselves. What kind of example is this for young children who accompany their parents when shopping? Noise would also affect residents who would use a library and the service centre.

6. Safety

This is a big concern, especially for the older members of our community. Bag-snatching and assaults are on the increase. It also affects younger children who are picked on by older children and youths in an attempt to gain money and other possessions that can be hocked off in exchange for money, drugs or alcohol.

Kyle Park

1. Swimming pool

Kyle Park would be a much better location for the proposed swimming pool. The southern end of the park, where the overgrown unfenced pond is, would be an ideal place and make better use of this area of waste land. With the exception of the BMX track, this locality is currently unused.

The northern end should be left alone as this is often used for local gatherings, gypsy fairs, circuses, and some sporting and community events. People also exercise their dogs there. There have been times when Hornby High School use it as well. With all three schools (High School, Intermediate and Primary) now being sited across the road, as well as a pre-school in Hei Hei Road, a swimming pool within walking distance would be of great benefit to the local community if built here.

It is only a short walk from the bus stop at Hornby Mall and through the railway underpass to this area. With more people using the underpass, any unsavoury characters would have to move on. Improved lighting and surveillance cameras could also be installed.

2. Asbestos

While it is acknowledged that the area contains asbestos, I feel it is irresponsible of the City Council not to spend money to remove this substance. In fact, in my opinion, by not doing so, the Council breaches the Health and Safety Act. Simply fencing off the area and leaving it to become over-grown is not the solution. Such areas in the past have created an opportunity for would-be arsonists.

3. Library and service centre

While the southern end of Kyle Park would not be large enough for the whole proposed complex to be built there, why not rebuild the library/service centre on the current library site in Goulding Avenue? A skilled architect, I am sure, could design an acceptable building. Multi-level buildings are not an obstacle provided there is adequate provisions for escalators, elevators and stairs. It already has a carpark which might be able to be extended or perhaps a small carpark building could be erected in conjunction with, and/or connected to, the library/service centre complex.

4. Safety

By splitting the complex as suggested, it would increase the safety of each group of people using that particular facility. Older people who are more likely to use the service centre and the library would not feel intimidated by large groups of idle youth. Young children would be accompanied by their parents. School age children and teenagers usually use the library services provided by their schools.

People using the swimming pool would go at the most suitable time for their age group, e.g. older people during the day, pre-school children with their parents, school age children with their teachers, etc.

5. Car parking

A portion of the southern end of Kyle Park could be allocated to car parking and secure bicycle stands. On-street parking along Waterloo Road is also available. (There could be opportunity to negotiate an arrangement with the Hornby school complex to lease out their car park during the weekends to cater for any overflow).

6. Noise, Litter, Graffiti and Vandalism

I feel that these issues would be limited by the splitting of the proposed complex.

I strongly object to the proposed changes to the District Plan regarding the classification of Denton Park as I think Kyle Park would be a far better choice and use of a currently under-utilised part of available land.

I do not wish to speak to my submission.

Council have already subdivided part of the park for housing.</p> <p>In the draft changes to the Denton Park Management Plan, Clause 3.11 make no parking allowance for these facilities. Graham Condon pool, that also neighbours a mall has over 60 car parks and you often can't get a park there. The Hornby Hub car parks are often full. Additional parking must be provided, and must not be at the cost of recreational space.</p> <p>The diversion of heavy traffic up Pound Road has not relieved traffic around the Hornby Hub. Traffic in this area is already at capacity. If these facilities are installed at Denton Park, significant investments need to be made in additional traffic lanes or link roads to Waterloo Road.</p> <p>Council note that other locations have been considered. Denton Park must remain as playing fields just as it is today.</p> <p>As an original submitter I was not given all the details on which to make a fully informed decision on this project and I cannot believe that none of the sites have been core drilled to determine what is beneath the surface.</p> <p>Why would you release the consultation document and not give submitters accurate up to date traffic plans especially when you know that this is already an extremely busy intersection. This means that if this location is confirmed, you will have to manipulate the traffic management plans to give the outcome you want to achieve.</p> <p>Why would you build this facility in Denton Park with a lack of parking? The plans indicate that CCC does not own any access to this site. Will this be just another budget over run to gratify staff indulgence in this site? Will you have to go back to Council for money to purchase shops on Chalmers Street to fulfil your dreams of providing access to the park via this traffic stagnant street? A street which is full of busses and cars that cannot move on a normal day.</p>

Where is the Traffic Report for this project? This report was promised to the submitters by both the Council and the Community Board. It is obviously very damning of the decision to use Denton Park otherwise staff would not have delayed its release.

Why have you placed the building on the number one ground hard up against the Rugby and Cricket pavilion? The aim of the pavilion is to allow people to watch the games in comfort but all they will be looking at is the concrete wall of a swimming pool. This appears to be a blatant attempt to drive the sporting codes out of Denton Park and use the pavilion area for car parks for the new pool.

Why is council staff trying to kill off sport in Hornby by reducing the number of fields to one undersized field on Denton Park? This will no longer be a number one ground for cricket because the boundaries are too small.

Parents with young children often have a child playing in two different grades. When fields are side by side as at Denton Park they can watch both games their children are playing in. Splitting the grounds by having one on Denton Park and one on Wycola Park will make it impossible for parents and volunteers to manage their sports as they do now.

Why wasn't the cost and design of upgrading Wycola Park included in the original consultation documents? As this is a legitimate cost of the staff plans to use Denton Park for the Leisure Centre. The costs should have been included in the original documents and not hidden from submitters.

Why was the cost of land repairs to Kyle Park added to the cost of this project? The land repair cost was to be achieved by reducing the size of the swimming pool on Kyle Park. If staff were to treat all sites as equal which is what they should do, why didn't they notify the upgrade of Wycola Park and reduce the size of the swimming pool on Denton Park to pay for that upgrade? We are told that the upgrade of Wycola Park will come out of another bucket of money. Why didn't the upgrade of Kyle Park come out of that same bucket?

Conclusion

I oppose the use of Denton Park for the building of the South West Leisure Centre.

CCC does not know what is below the surface because core samples haven't been taken.

CCC has not provided a Traffic Report in this area of high traffic density.

The land was gifted to the people of CHC as a reserve for sporting fields not buildings.

CCC has voted in favour of using Denton Park so they must now provide commissioners from councils in the North Island to make the judgment on this issue.

To Whom It May Concern,

Sport and recreation offer social, cultural and physical benefits to individuals, family/whanau and the wider community. Thousands of Cantabrians receive countless benefits from sport and physical activity every day. They rely, however, on having the right spaces in their own communities, that provide quality experiences for participants.

Swimming is the third most popular activity amongst New Zealanders, after walking and cycling, and 33.4% of Cantabrians took part in some form of swimming activity over the past 12 months. In the 5 to 18-year age group this accounted for 78% of boys and 86% of girls.

Learning to swim, therefore, is a critical life skill, and our national drowning statistics clearly show that this is skill our communities need easy and affordable access to.

An indoor heated pool at Denton Park in Hornby, will be a community facility that will attract and draw users from the wider South West area, giving the community an alternative to having to travel to Jellie Park, Pioneer and Graeme Condon which are already nearing capacity (and are at peak times over capacity), in terms of users. This facility will be ideally located to draw significant numbers for learn to swim and training programs.

Swimming Canterbury West Coast is the regional association for competitive swimming, it incorporates 17-member Clubs and a total membership of over 1850.

Participation rates in our sport have returned to levels pre-earthquake and are continuing to grow. With Christchurch's population due to increase by approximately 96,000 over the next 20 years, we expect that our numbers will continue to rise, and while we acknowledge that public aquatic centres are primarily provided to service the aquatic needs of the wider community, they will greatly alleviate the pressures on pool space.

Two of Swimming Canterbury West Coast's member Clubs have already expressed strong desire to secure lane space allocation at the proposed Hornby Aquatic Centre at Denton Park, and could potentially account for 5hrs entire pool hire, per day for up to 6 days per week.

The development of significant local hubs throughout the greater Christchurch area, such as the proposed aquatic centre at Denton Park, are desperately needed to service a growing demand on our city's limited resources, particularly when it comes to Aquatic Facilities and available lane space.

Swimming Canterbury West Coast supports the proposed development of the Hornby Recreation and Sport Centre at Denton Park in Hornby. We believe this location is ideal to service the growing population in the South West of Christchurch, and that the addition of this new service and recreation facility will be of significant benefit, not just to Swimming Canterbury West Coast members, but to the wider community.
