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Planting to bund, with bollards to restrict access. Levels tbc, however recommend max 1:20 path to get up to path height on top of bund.

Jetty or ramp access over revetment.

Seating space at entrance with wayfinding signage

Potential space for bioretention (low point of terrain) 300mm excavation max. Potential inclusion of riparian species.

Inclusion of narratives throughout the project corridor.

Community garden - Fruit/ berry orchard

Planting to bund. Planting extends out beyond bund extent to create more naturalistic aesthetic to space and break lineal nature of bund

Access for small recreational paddlecraft to jetty/ ramp. Bollards to restrict vehicle access.

Area identified on site for cultural narrative. A more significant position due to the panoramic view afforded from the existing small jetty. This was an ideal place to tell the greater narrative, with a view of the whole skyline across Ihutai – with significant peaks available to the visitor to view. This space would benefit from the opportunity to get the path user out above the estuary (on site we recognised that the panorama was available from about 5 metres out on the jetty).
