

Sorry we're in your way

We're working along Ferry Road

Sections of the stormwater drains beneath Ferry Road are damaged and need to be fixed. Repairs include installing new manholes and new pipe lining. This means we need to dig up parts of the road.

We're doing this work over summer when the drains are dry and clean.

Initial construction work began on 4 December 2023 at one manhole. Work will stop before Christmas and recommence on 8 January 2024.

Traffic changes

While work is in progress on manhole B and manhole C, there will be right turning restrictions at the intersection and side roads.

There will be no right turns from Ferry Road into Aldwins Road (coming from the east) and into Ensors Road (coming from the west).

All through traffic lanes on Ferry Road, Ensors Road, and Aldwins Road will be maintained with a 30km/h speed restriction.

We know road works are disruptive for you and we'll do our best to keep traffic flowing.

Intersection work

While we're repairing the stormwater drains, we're planning to replace the traffic signals at the Ferry/Ensors/Aldwins intersection as they have reached the end of their working life.

We're also planning to make safety improvements to the intersection by installing safe speed platforms. We will confirm the dates of the safety work early in 2024.

In March 2024 we're beginning to install pipe lining. This will take between 8-25 days per manhole site. Not all sites require lining.



Manholes

- A** Work underway and will take three weeks. Restarts 8 January if required.
- B** Work begins 8 January and will take 5-6 weeks.
- C** Work begins 8 January and will take 14 days. Restricted access to Hart Street, with resident access maintained.
- D** Work begins once manhole C is completed and will take 14 days.
- E** Work begins once manhole D is completed and will take 14 days.
