All parties wishing to undertake works or activities that impact utilisation of road space in the central city between 17 August and 28 September 2020.

PURPOSE

Restrict worksites and activities on the roading network within the Central City area surrounding the Justice and Emergency Services Precinct.

DETAIL

At the request of key partner agencies there will be worksite and activity restrictions it placedue to an upcoming event at the Justice and Emergency Precinct. No new works will be about a securior without specific permission within an area surrounding the Justice and Emergency Precinct. No new worksites will be able to be established after 7am 17 August 2020 and a few reactly established will need to be removed prior to 6pm 19 August 2020 through to 28 September 2020.

- 1. Contractors with existing sites will be asked to reduce the n pact or remove the site within this period, a TTM team member will contact contractors should won site amendment or removal be required.
- 2. For contractors who plan to undertake work unising Generic Plans within the areas shown on the attached map, works will not be permitted in the e days.
- 3. Work activities may be permitted to be under aken where specific permission has been granted by a CTOC Traffic Management Team prember. Please contact the CTOC TTM duty mailbox to seek permission.

Works on the network, other than in estricted roads, remain unimpacted by these restrictions.

Works may return to normal from 00:01 Monday 28 September 2020.
